By the end of this half term, children should know the following facts. The aim is for them to be able to recall these facts instantly.

Children should be able to explore pairs of numbers that add up to a number within 5 (number bonds).



Top Tips



It is important to practise these facts little and often. You do not have to practise them all at once; you could choose a fact for the day. You could practise these KIRFs whilst walking to school or during a car journey. If you would like more ideas on how to support your child's learning, please speak to their teacher.

Things to try at home

- Use Lego bricks, counters, or toys to investigate the different number bonds to five. Or if you're out and about; use leaves, shells or sticks.
- Choose a number and then ask them to use their fingers on both hands to show you how they make it. E.g. 4 I and 3 make 4 2 and 2 make 4. Challenge them to make the same number in multiple ways.
