



Key Instant Recall Facts EYFS - Spring 1



I can explore the composition of numbers to 5

By the end of this half term, children should know the following facts. The aim is for them to be able to recall these facts **instantly**.

Children should be able to explore pairs of numbers that add up to a number within 5 (number bonds).

E.g.

1 and 3 make 4





0 and 2 make 2

3 and 2 make 5

Top Tips

It is important to practise these facts **little** and **often**. You do not have to practise them all at once; you could choose a fact for the day. You could practise these KIRFs whilst walking to school or during a car journey. If you would like more ideas on how to support your child's learning, please speak to their teacher.

Things to try at home

- Use Lego bricks, counters, or toys to investigate the different number bonds to five. Or if you're out and about; use leaves, shells or sticks.
- Choose a number and then ask them to use their fingers on both hands to show you how they make it. E.g.   1 and 3 make 4   2 and 2 make 4. Challenge them to make the same number in multiple ways.
