Dear Parents/Carers,

Welcome back! We are pleased to be back and we hope that your children have enjoyed their first few days with us and are starting to feel more settled. So far we have been mightily impressed by the children's behaviour and how well they have adapted to the changes around school.

Home Learning

**Home learning will be available on Seesaw on Fridays to be completed by the following Wednesday. This will begin on Friday 13th of September.

Reading

The expectation is that your child will read at home for 20 minutes per evening and record what they have read in their reading record, followed by an initial from an adult.

Spelling

Each week, the children will be given a few words (via Seesaw or spelling frame) to practise, ready for their spelling test each Friday morning. These will be linked to specific spelling patterns we are learning in class. Additionally, on the Year 5 page on our School website, is a copy of the Year 3/4 and 5/6 spelling words that they will be working through as well; they should be aware of the few words that they are practising that week.

Times Tables

We would also encourage regular times tables practise up to 12X12.


PE

Each week Year 5 will have outdoor PE on Friday and indoor PE on Tuesday. Please continue to send your child into school in their PE kits, trainers and school sweater on their PE days. During the colder months, we would advise joggers as the PE will be outdoors, also spare socks etc if they get wet! Every Wednesday afternoon, the children will be on a 3 week rotation of Problem Solving maths, Additional PE or Spanish. We will make sure your child knows what their session will be for the week beforehand and if they will need an appropriate kit.

Please be reminded that if your child wears earrings, then they must either remove them for PE or bring in tape to cover them.







Personal Belongings

Your child may wish to have their own pencil case with their own stationery in the classroom; this is absolutely fine but please remind them that their own belongings are their responsibility and need to be looked after by them.

More recently, we have found that some children are bringing mobile phones into school, often because they are walking home on their own. Can we reiterate that any phones brought to school must be switched off as soon as your child enters the school grounds, handed to their teacher at the beginning of the school day and can only be switched on again as your child leaves the school grounds. If you wish your child to bring a mobile phone to school, please ask for a permission slip at the school office. Smart watches are not permitted to be worn in school.

It is extremely important that the children come to school with a water bottle and a coat every day.

Please make sure that if your child has any regular medication that you have filled out a form from the office and that the medication kept in school is their most recently prescribed dosage and that it is within date.

We are always here to help you so please alert us to any issues you may have or any changes at home. You can contact us in several ways:
